The Department of Veterans Affairs has a pension program known as "Aid and Attendance" that pays for personal care and attendant home services.

The applicant must be a veteran (or the surviving spouse of a veteran) who:



**Served at least 90 consecutive days of active duty, with at least one day of service during wartime**

**Needs assistance at home due to disabilities not connected to military service**



**Has limited income and assets relative to medical expenses**
